NEW LANGUAGE LEARNING OFFERS

- PARLE course for students in 7th, 8th, and 9th grade English (AEFE)
- Additional hours of Danish language instruction in college
- In progress: An international English program at the lycée level.

INTERDISCIPLINARY LANGUAGE TEACHING

- Multilingual choir
